Arbor Day Recognized With a Special Tree Planting with Arlington Kiwanis

Arlington Kiwanis members will plant a flowering pink snowbell tree on Saturday, March 30th in memory of George Boulton. They are honoring George for his lifetime service in the Arlington Kiwanis Club. A tree memorial creates a lasting tribute and benefits the community.
