

## **Week 5 – Life on the edge**

**Goal – To make students comfortable with using the measuring tool, launching an editing session and tracing physical features on the interactive map to create their own layer**

**Note – The GeoMentor created a customized lesson map with Glacier Peak lahar layer from USGS and vents from Snohomish County. The GeoMentor was also unable to instruct this week. Additional classroom material should be obtained through Glacier Peak Institute**

1. Classroom lecture and PowerPoint presentation
2. Have students open the lesson map and click on the Darrington Area bookmark and answer Question 1.
3. Introduce students to the measuring tool on the map interface – have them click on the drop-down selections to select miles
4. Have students measure the distance between the White Chuck vent and Darrington and answer Questions 2 – 4.
