



'Covered' Employment (In-City Jobs): City of Arlington WA

This report was prepared from 2010 data from the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages conducted by the Washington State Department of Employment Security as geo-coded and adjusted by the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC). The information below will be updated in June 2012, and will include numbers for total employers as well. (Note: NAICS = North American Industry Classification System.)

These data points include individuals covered by unemployment insurance – in government and private-sector jobs, but not solo proprietors, corporate officers, military, railroad employees, ministry workers, and some others. Where totals represent fewer than three reporting firms, or when one employer accounts for more than 80 percent of jobs, the total is withheld – noted by asterisk (*) to protect company privacy.
