

SR 530 Design

Vision

As the subarea's primary roadway, SR 530 is a key component of Island Crossing's future. SR 530 has the potential to become a safe, reliable route for users of all modes to access Island Crossing, Arlington, and the surrounding region.

Considerations

- Street design should accommodate and incorporate all users, regardless of purpose and duration of visit, and travel mode.
- Safety improvements should consider consolidated driveways, frontage roads to control ingress/egress, and left turn lane removal with implementation of the Smokey Point Blvd/SR 530 roundabout.
- Pedestrian crossings should be more frequent, visible, and strategically placed.
- WSDOT projects to improve capacity of I-5/SR 530 interchange are identified in the Comprehensive Plan.
- The Olympic Pipeline (a critical gas line) runs through the subarea; coordination with the Olympic Pipeline Company is needed to understand safety risks from potential SR 530 design changes and recurring flooding.
- Several informal farmstands pop up along 530; consider consolidation to support this activity as a destination.
