I would like to express my concerns regarding the plan for a metal processing plant to be built near the residence of Glenn Eagle. As a resident here, I do not agree that this is in our best interest. The health of the residence should be priority. Hot dip galvanization produces toxic fumes, inhalation of these fumes will lead to long-term health problems. This plant can cause BOTH lead AND zinc from the galvanized steel to vaporize. Exposure to lead is particularly dangerous. There are plenty of NON RESIDENTIAL areas to build such a plant. Consider more over down 172nd where the airport has a steady blowing wind to keep the fumes from sticking around.
