Good morning Amy.

I wanted to bring to your attention that there's a proposal for a galvanized plant to be established on 67th Street near the Glen Eagle neighborhood. This is particularly worrisome for us as newcomers to Washington and this specific neighborhood.

My main concerns are twofold: Firstly, the potential exposure to toxic fumes and subsequent health risks for us and our neighbors. Secondly, the proximity of this plant to a large, beautiful family housing community. I strongly believe such facilities should be situated as far away from residential areas as possible.

Additionally, the increased traffic that the facility would bring and the visual impact it would have on our subdivision are also concerning to us. We moved here to enjoy Arlington's beauty, and we hope this proposal can be reconsidered for a different location that would better preserve the charm of our community.
