Dear Ms. Rusko,

It has come to my wife and my attention that there has been a proposal submitted to establish a hot dip galvanizing process plant at 18520 - 67th Ave., right at the entrance of the Gleneagle residential area.

We are very concerned and oppose this proposal.

Hot dip galvanization produces toxic fumes. Inhalation of these fumes can lead to long-term health problems, as the process can cause both lead and zinc from the galvanized steel to vaporize. Exposure to lead is particularly dangerous and is known to cause numerous serious health issues, including cancer.

The proximity of the proposed plant to the Glen Eagle residences is alarming. This location is unsuitable for metal chemical processing activities, especially given its placement in the heart of a residential area.

We are strongly against this proposal and strongly urge you to NOT allow approval of the proposed project.
