I have received notice of the proposal to establish a hot dip galvanizing process plant at 18520 67th Ave, and am writing to express my grave concern and extreme opposition to having yet another toxic and troublesome industrial site in such close proximity to the Gleneagle neighborhood, where my family has resided for the past 26 years.

It is my understanding that hot dip galvanization produces toxic fumes, inhalation of which can lead to numerous serious health problems, including cancer. There is no question that the 67th Ave location is suitable for the proposed plant, given these risks to my own, my family's, and our neighbors' health.

Please pass along my concerns to the decision makers and keep me informed as to the next steps to register my opposition to the proposal.
