My name is Ryan Olson and I live in Arlington. Thus, my family and I would be very close to this galvanizing plant - 2 blocks to be exact. This information that I have come across about the dangers of this "processing plant" terrifies me. If only half of what I've read about these "hot dip" dangers are true, these types of processing plants SHOULD NOT BE LOCATED ANYWHERE NEAR HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS. Please consider all the families that would be affected by these toxic fumes and reject this proposal. If not, I will work with my neighbors to vote out anyone on the city council who votes yes for this proposal.
