Ms Rusko,

After reading about the proposed development of the property on 67<sup>th</sup> and the close proximity to the GlenEagle neighborhood I must register my concerns about its construction and Environmental impacts. I have read many of your exhibits and attached reports. The air quality issues bother me... I read thoroughly the PSCCA report. I see that this site will be monitored for air and I assume groundwater pollutants however I do not see any plans for perimeter air quality samplings. I feel that with the 1000+ families so close and soon another 100+ apartments right across the street (not happy at all with the traffic flow issues with THAT project either but that is for another day) there should be plans for air samples in multiple locations within GlenEagle with frequencies TBD by the PSCAA .

Overall, I feel there has got to be a site in a more suitable industrial area of Arlington such as Gayteway Business Park further north along. 67<sup>th</sup> .

In closing, I believe this proposal should be rejected and that an alternate site should be sought.
