Arlington Police Detectives Solve Robberies, Arrest Multiple Suspects

(Arlington, WA) - On August 16th, 2023, at approximately 1:45a.m., Arlington Police Officers were dispatched to a Robbery incident at a 7-11 convenience store located at 540 N. West Ave Arlington. Reports to 9-1-1 were that two white males had jumped over the counter, assaulted the store clerk, and stole items during the commission of the robbery. Arlington Police Criminal Investigations Division conducted an investigation and developed probable cause to arrest two 17-year-old males from Arlington, WA for Robbery 1st degree. On 10/17/23 the two juveniles were arrested and booked into the Denny Youth Center for Robbery 1st Degree and Harassment-Threats to Kill. (Reference Case #2023-00016173).

On a separate and unrelated incident on October 14th 2023 at approximately 5:15a.m., Arlington Police Officers responded to a report of a robbery involving a handgun at an espresso stand in the 16800 block of Smokey Point Blvd Arlington, WA. Arlington Police learned that a barista had been robbed by a suspect wearing a ski mask and armed with a handgun. Arlington Police Officers and Detectives quickly developed suspect vehicle information and determined through investigation the owner of the vehicle was a 37-year-old Marysville man. Arlington Police located the vehicle in the 5900 block of 172nd St NE Arlington, WA and arrested the 37-year-old Marysville man. A 33-year-old Lake Stevens man was arrested as an accomplice to the Robbery, as well as arrested on an outstanding felony warrant from the Department of Corrections (DOC) for escaping community custody on an original charge of Kidnapping 1st Degree. Both males were booked into the Snohomish County Jail for Robbery 1st Degree, Unlawful Possession of a Firearm 1st Degree, Assault 2nd Degree, and Theft 3rd. (Reference Case #2023-00020620).
