## WHAT CAN I BRING?

Clean up clutter at your business and comply with regulations by properly disposing of unused chemicals. Look for the words CAUTION, POISON, WARNING, DANGER, CAUSTIC, COMBUSTIBLE, FLAMMABLE or CORROSIVE on the label, or for similar chemical symbols.



Common business chemicals include:

- Aerosol cans
- Antifreeze
- Automotive fluids
- Batteries
- Bleach
- Drain cleaner
- Fluorescent bulbs/tubes
- Gasoline/diesel
- Herbicides
- Insecticides
- Latex-based and oil-based paint, varnish and stain
- Paint thinner
- Propane tanks
