Description of Proposed Project: Annex approximately 97.8 acres located south of 172nd Street NE/SR 531 between SR 9 and the future alignment of 75th Avenue NE. The properties are within the City Urban Growth Area (UGA), and the current City limits abuts the proposed annexation area to the Northern and Eastern boundaries. The City's Comprehensive Plan designates the area as Residential Ultra Low Capacity with a Master Plan Neighborhood Overlay. The zoning map pre-zones this area with the same designations.

Testimony: Any interested person has the right to submit written testimony to the City regarding this action as well as the right to appear at the public hearing and give oral testimony.
