PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The City of Arlington has initiated a code amendment to include the proposed Old Town Residential Design Standards as a reference document for development within the Old Town Residential District. The Old Town Residential Design Standards propose to implement design regulations to properties within the Old Town Residential District to maintain, preserve, and protect the historical and architectural style represented in this zone.

SEPA THRESHOLD DETERMINATION: The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2) (c).
